## Safely... opening when you need us

- The majority of pharmacies in Lancashire are currently back to normal opening hours
- Check with your usual pharmacy when they are open if you need to be sure
- Your prescription might be sent directly to us electronically by your surgery
- If this is new for you, just ask and we'll tell you how it works and about any changes



## Safely... providing the care you need



- We haven't stopped supplying and selling medicines and now the majority of pharmacies in Lancashire are currently offering their usual, wide range of other services
- Check with your usual pharmacy what services they are offering if you need to be sure
- You can come to us for help with minor ailments and long term conditions
- We are preparing to provide flu vaccinations this Autumn

## Safely... working with social distancing

- You may notice some changes when you visit your usual pharmacy for the first time
- It may feel strange but they are there to keep you safe
- If you have been shielding you may feel nervous however we have measures in place to keep you safe
- Follow social distancing measures in your usual pharmacy
